Kinder 2 (K2)
Selection Criteria Team BC & BC Quota

1. Provincial K2 Selection process

All selection for Team BC and BC Quota will be based on the overall results from the K2 Provincial Championship series (Panorama and Big White) using the Provincial Ranking Series. The PRS will be tabulated as follows:

Single best SG, GS and SL result using the PRS scoring from the two series (Panorama, Big White) will be tabulated for a combined PRS score. In the event of a tie, the next best result, regardless of discipline, will be taken into consideration; further ties will be broken by any remaining results.

Once an athlete is named to a team they are no longer eligible for other team or quota spots. ie. If an athlete is named to Team Canada they are no longer eligible for Team BC or BC quota spots.

2. K2 Team CANADA 2009 - K2's selection: 18 athletes (9 males / 9 females)

Team Canada 1, 2, 3: Three teams of ten will be formed to represent Canada at the Whistler Cup. Each Team will consist of 6 K2 athletes and 4 K1 athletes.

Team Leader and Selection Committee: The Team leader will be named by ACA in collaboration with the provincial Technical directors. The Selection Committee will be composed of the Program/Technical Directors for BC, Alberta, Ontario, Quebec and Canada District and Benoit Lalande (Alpine Canada Alpin).

K2 Selection Criteria for Team Canada 1, 2 and 3

* 18 Spots (9 males and 9 females) will be decided from the K2 Canadian Championships to attend a Whistler Cup Preparation Camp run by ACA, at which the final selection for Team Canada 1, 2 and 3 will be decided.

- The selection of the 18 spots will be decided initially from the gold, silver and bronze medallists at the K2 Canadian Championships. From 4 events per gender at the K2 Canadian Championships, there are 12 possible medals per gender. The highest medal placing take precedence. If less than 18 individuals from medal calculations occur, then the overall result calculations will be used to select for the available spots.
- In the event of ties the next best placing from other events will be used
- Further ties will be broken by race point differences
- DNF's are equivalent to a non medal result

3. K2 Team BC 2009 - K2's selection: 12 athletes (6 males / 6 females)

The Team Leaders for Team BC will be Gordie Bowles and Leslie Clarke, both from BC Alpine. The Selection Committee will be composed of the Team Leader and the available Provincial Coaches

Council reps from K1 and K2 (total possible 8 reps). Athletes named to Team BC will travel and train with their regular club teams. **Team BC:** Top 6 males and 6 females (excluding BC athletes named to Team Canada) based on the above selection process and results from the K2 Nationals.

4. BC Quota - K2's selection (10 males / 10 females)

Selection and seeding of remaining K2 athletes will also be based on the overall results at the K2 Provincial Championships and any Gold medal winner at the Western K2 Championships or Gold Cup will receive a spot from this quota for all events. Entries are to include confirmed athletes as well as the name of the coaches who will be accompanying the group.
