

FIS Update January 15th, 2024

This update is geared towards those athletes who are not doing the Kimberly speed project and will be traveling out to Panorama for the Tech race Feb 1-4.

Logistics

For the athletes who will not be skiing Kimberly we will have training here in Whistler Thursday to Sunday. For this week's training plan, I will send out on Wednesday as we are pushing for GS and will be able to get up and look at the race centre on Wednesday morning to decide if GS is a viable option. Alternatively we will continue with SL training for Thursday and Friday training. In terms of getting to and from **Panorama this group will now be driving**. The plan will be to load the truck and trailer on Tuesday Jan 30th at the WMSC and drive to Panorama Jan 31st. We will all rendezvous back in Panorama where we will race from Feb 1-4th. Everyone will come home on the 5th; the speed group will fly home on the 5th and the tech group will drive home on the 5th. We found an SUV with winter tires that was substantially cheaper than other rental companies plus could guarantee proper snow tires so this is a much better option then flying the athletes in and out for this project. The athletes will be responsible for cooking their meals and the food will be covered by the team.
